Explanation of Ventilation Schemes

Certification of natural persons

1. Grease Hygiene Operative (GHO01) - For personnel who carry out the cleaning of grease extract systems. The course offers training and assessment in the knowledge, skills & behaviours required to safely clean grease extract systems and associated components.
2. Grease Hygiene Technician (GHT02) - For personnel who carry out the cleaning of grease extract systems. The course offers training and assessment in the knowledge, skills & behaviours required to safely clean grease extract systems and associated components, carry out pre & post clean testing & reporting and site person in charge responsibilities.
3. Air Hygiene Operative (AHO01) - For personnel who carry out the cleaning of general ventilation systems. The course offers training and assessment in the knowledge, skills & behaviours required to safely clean general ventilation systems and associated components.
4. Air Hygiene Technician (AHT02) - For personnel who carry out the cleaning of general ventilation systems. The course offers training and assessment in the knowledge, skills & behaviours required to safely clean general ventilation systems and associated components, carry out pre & post clean testing & reporting and site person in charge responsibilities.

Where a certificate bears the logo for the European Ventilation Hygiene Association (EVHA) as well as 'BESA Training' this has been delivered by a licensed or satellite centre from BESA Training.

The EVHA Scheme is open to EU & UK citizens not operational in the UK.
